

Marriage: Please contact the parish office before setting your date. The Church asks that couples be parish members for at least 6 months before setting a date. Participation in Pre-Cana and a Premarital Inventory required.

From the Desk of Fr. Larry...

My friends, in his post-Resurrection appearances, Jesus continues to teach his disciples as he prepares to leave them to ascend to the right hand of the Father in heaven, then sending their Holy Spirit to them and us to be Their loving everyday Presence to us. For me, today's Gospel is a whole lesson about how to minister to others, a model for us all.

As He appears, He greets them with "Peace be with you!". He has never used that greeting with them before in the Scriptures. The peace Jesus refers to is the peace of shalom, meaning 'whatever needs to happen in your life to bring wholeness and healing and a total integration of body, mind and spirit is what I wish for you.'

Then he shows them his scars from his nail and spear wounds, indicating our need to be vulnerable to others, knowing they are carrying scars or open wounds and wanting to connect in mutual support.

Then, for the first time in the Gospels, he asks for something to eat, indicating our need to respond to the physical, emotional, and spiritual hunger in others. Then He opens the meaning of Old Testament Scriptures to them, how He is the manifestation of the long-awaited Christ/ Messiah who freely offers mercy, forgiveness and unconditional love to all people.

He summarizes it all with these words, "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem." And then he gives them their Commission in these words: You are witnesses of these things."

In other words, those disciples – and all of us – are to bear witness to Christ's living Presence in the world through our greeting, relationship building, responding to the hungers in others, sharing how Christ has played a role in our lives, bearing witness to our personal relationship with Christ AND how our faith community has consistently helped us in doing this. Our Gospel today is the template for true, authentic Christian discipleship in the Lord! May we continue to do our best in modeling this, making it a natural part of our witness to God's love in the world!
